The New York State English Language Arts (ELA) test is administered to 3rd - 8th graders in the beginning of April. The State has set higher learning standards for all students. To reach these standards, the ELA test challenges students to demonstrate their ability to listen attentively, read a variety of materials, and respond in writing to literary and informational passages. Students will work each week on previous tests given as well as work on note taking skills for the listening section and practice on writing well developed responses.

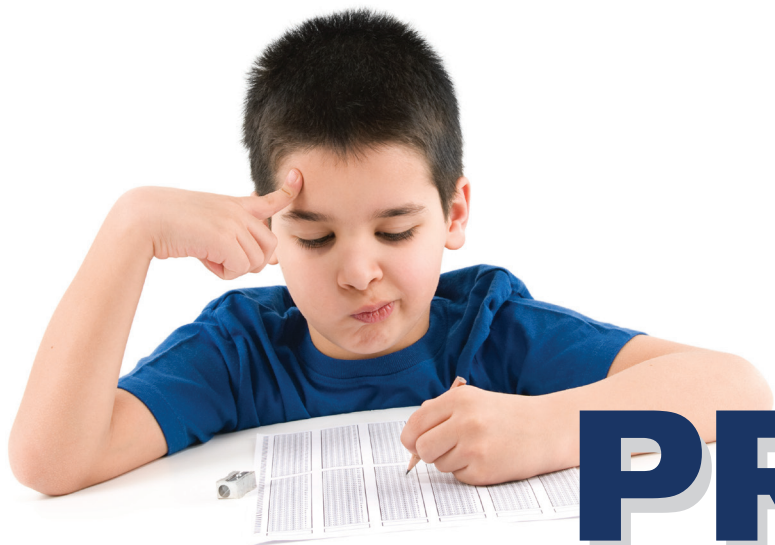

MATH

The New York State Math test is administered to 3rd - 8th graders in the beginning of May. The purpose of this test is to find out which concepts have been mastered at each grade level and which need further development. This test will include multiple choice questions, short response, and extended response questions. The multiple choice component presents students with questions utilizing a variety of skills. The short and extended response questions require students to write (rather than select) an appropriate response. These questions will allow students to take different paths to a solution and to use different strategies. Students will work each week on a variety of previous State test practice sheets and practice using the tools needed for the test.
